

WHAT'S FUNDED

Our current funding is for a new playspace in a new location to:

- Capitalise on the unique view west to the Blue Mountains
- Faciliate improved connectivity with adjacent footpaths

The new playspace will include:

- Play equipment & softfall
- · Shade trees to the north and west
- A shade structure
- Picnic facilities
- Seating, both formal and informal
- Path connections

WHAT'S NOT FUNDED

Future works that are not covered by the current funding could include:

- Additional tree planting for shade, habitat and amenity
- A scooter / small wheeled toy track around the playspace
- A loop path around the entire park
- A BMX/pump track utilising the existing slope (and pending outcome of community engagement)
- Additional seating and picnic areas

THE CONCEPT



"Can I get there?"

- · The playspace will be relocated to better connect with existing footpaths, public transport and roadside parking opportunities
- 1.5m wide concrete path connection will be provided between the playspace and street



"Can I play?"

The new playspace design is to be developed in collaboration with community and stakeholders to provide a variety of equipment and surfacing that will enable everyone to experience a variety of challenging and engaging experiences



"Can I stay?"

- The new playspace design will include shade, picnic facilities anad a variety of seating opportunities to ensure everyone can stay at the playspace for as long as they like.
- · Pending final available funding, desirable additions could include an accessible drinking fountain with water bottle refill and dog bowl
