Concept Overview.

Set in the open parklands of Cambridge Garden, the proposed youth space reflects its surrounding context through earthy tones and features. Low level timber logs and steppers throughout the space help to ground the design in its natural surroundings.

While the parkour elements in undulating terrain, climbing bars, bouldering wall provide adventurous users with element to challenge and improve balance and strength. Parkour vaults double as "hangout zones," while a shelter with seating provides more formal social space. The flying fox and basket swing provide more traditional, timeless play space elements for all to enjoy.

The bmx/scooter pump track surrounding the submerged 3ft beginner bowl with 5ft extension provides opportunities for all ages and abilities to participate in wheeled sports activity.

Overall, while aimed at youth, the space that is suitable for all ages and respectful of its natural environment.

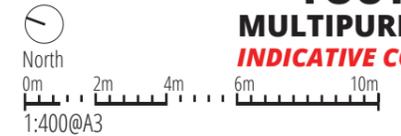
