Dorothy Radford was a founding member of the St Marys Development Committee, affectionately known as Mrs St Marys. She was St Marys' first Citizen of the Year in 2001. She received the Order of Australia membership in 2003 for services to the community of Penrith, particularly through veteran, youth and aged care groups. She was involved with the Meals on Wheels service in St Marys, the Girl Guides program, the St Marys RSL, and many other community organisations.
