

Coreen Avenue and Lemongrove Road

Council has conducted extensive traffic investigations and future traffic modelling which assessed the Coreen Avenue and Lemongrove Road intersection performance as failing in both AM and PM peak periods by 2036.

Significant delays at this intersection are currently experienced in the AM peak period caused by the heavy number of vehicles turning right from Coreen Avenue (western approach) which results in long queues that spill back to Bel-Air Road.

Proposed changes:

- Upgrade existing traffic signals with dual right-turn lane into Lemongrove Road.
- New pedestrian refuge.
- New footpath.
- New streetlights.

Benefits include:

- Widening lanes will improve the traffic flow along Coreen Avenue.
- Traffic signal phasing will improve pedestrian safety.
- New footpaths and refuge will improve pedestrian safety.
- Street lighting will enhance visibility and improve safety at night.
- Contribute to the overall performance of Coreen Avenue during peak periods.

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
